

## **SHEFFIELD WORKING WOMEN'S OPPORTUNITIES PROJECT (SWWOP)**

We are a small voluntary sector project and registered charity, working with very vulnerable women who are involved in street sex work. We have a regular outreach service which provides harm reduction and advice to women on the streets, and the 'REST' service which supports women to exit street sex work.

Due to a successful funding bid for a new post to expand our service, we are wishing to recruit a female\* Outreach Follow Up Support Worker to join our team. She will be someone who has experience of working with vulnerable women, understands the complexities of street sex work, and is committed to SWWOP's ethos.

This is a part-time post of 20 hours per week at a remuneration of £24,882 pa pro rata plus 8% pension. The post is initially for 12 months, with a possible two year extension.
